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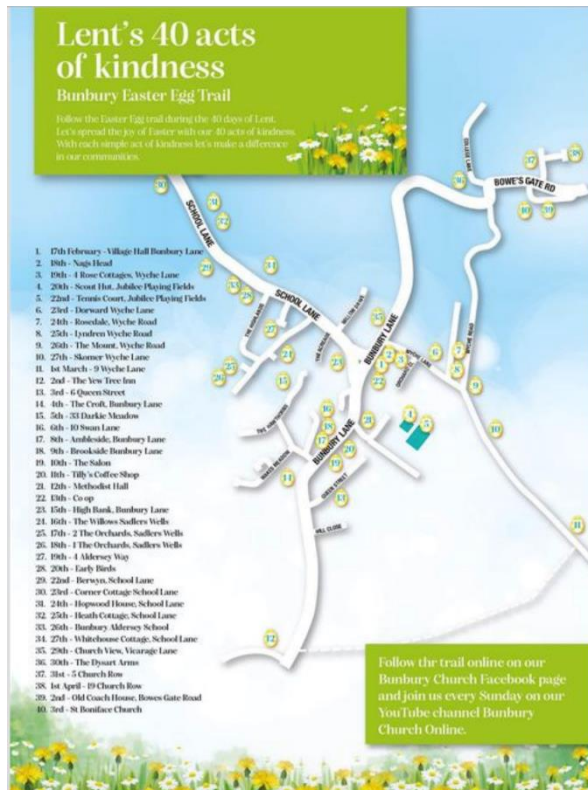
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Easter Egg Trail

We are also participating as a school in the Easter Egg Trail being organised by St Boniface Church. You can see below the map and dates of each Easter Egg reveal. As a school, we want as many children to participate by making a paper mache egg and decorating it with anything which has made them happy over the past 12 months.



These will be outside for a number of weeks so will need to be coated in either varnish or PVA glue for protection. As a school we will be placing them along the top of our hedge at the front and side of school so that as people can see them safely from the roadside. Each egg will have a QR code near to it. Please drop off any completed eggs in school over the next few weeks so that we are able to display them outside on the hedge.
