Today the children have learnt about the countries culture as well as learning traditional dances and listening to music. There were also art, Geography and language activities in classes throughout the day.

We look forward to providing our children with invaluable experiences and lessons, which teach them about life there as our link strengthens and grows. We are also excited to share our culture and traditions and are delighted to have Castelao Primary as an extension of our Bunbury family.


