Dear Parents and carers

Our first full week in school is complete and I am delighted to say that all children and staff have settled back into school brilliantly. The smiling faces continue to greet me at the school gate and the enthusiasm from the children as they run up the school drive is infectious.

After a few days last week re-igniting our school ethos and vision we have returned this week to full curriculum learning. There is as always a buzz and excitement within our classrooms with all our staff team making learning as it should be: fun, exciting, enjoyable and engaging.

This year we have introduced a new approach to the teaching of writing and are now using Pathways to Write to support our curriculum. This links in with our current approaches used for reading and spelling: Pathways to Read and Pathways to Spell. The approach is still very much book based with a quality text driving the learning

and has also enabled us to continue with our connected teaching approach to the foundation subjects. We very much look forward to sharing our Pathways

To continue to enhance our RE curriculum and strengthen our links with St Boniface church, KS2 classes will each be walking to church during the year to witness a different service linked to our school Christian values. These services will be led by Reverend Tim Havward.

FAMILY OPEN ACCESS APPOINTMENTS

This 45-minute appointment can be either face to face, online or by telephone, with a Family Wellbeing Worker and is an opportunity for a parent(s) to talk, offload, get initial tips, guidance, coping strategies and to discuss pathways of support. PARENT CARER WORKSHOP PROGRAMME Helping support a child manage their worries and anxiety (7 x 90-minute weekly workshops)

This programme is evidence based and explores various parenting techniques which can be applied to support an anxious child. The learning is cumulative each week so requires commitment to all seven sessions. This programme is extremely popular so may have a waiting list.



PARENT CARER WORKSHOP PROGRAMME Sleep (1 x 90-minute Workshop & 1 tailored family session)

This programme is evidence based and will support you in understanding why your child may be struggling to sleep. We will explore the science of sleep and practical strategies to support sleep. Available for families of children in reception and above.

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This workshop helps you to understand what death, grief and bereavement mean to a child and why they may struggle saying goodbye. We explore techniques to help support a child to cope with grief.



PARENT CARER WORKSHOP (90-minute Workshop)
Understanding self-harm

This workshop looks at the relationship between self-harm and suicide. We look at ways to support a person who is self-harming and break down some of the stigmas associated with self-harm and suicide. This workshop explains where to get further support for a person who is expressing thoughts of suicide.



PARENT CARER WORKSHOP (90-minute Workshop)
Supporting a child with anxiety

This workshop aims to help you to understand the various ways which anxiety presents itself in children and offers ideas on how to support your child to manage their anxiety.



PARENT CARER WORKSHOP (90-minute Workshop)
Supporting a child with the world of social media

This workshop looks at how to support your child with peer pressure and online bullying. Learn how to build their selfesteem and break through the negativity of the 24-hord online world. Look at how to support your child with a healthy relationship with the online world and get over that FOMO (Fear of Missing Out).
