Dear Parents and carers

Another week in school has passed by and I can't believe we are nearly at half term. Firstly, I'd like to thank you for all your positive comments regarding our Harvest Service last week. I am always extremely proud of the children at such events and it is heartening to hear that this is also shared within our parent and school community.

This week I met with our parent council for our half termly meeting. I am delighted to work with such an enthusiastic team of people who work with the school to ensure the provision is the very best it can for our Bunbury children.

One of the points raised was around the teaching of subjects in school. As a school we have a dedicated, committed and highly skilled staff team who receive regular CPD to ensure practice is as up to date as possible. Having been in the profession for over 2 decades there have been many changes to the curriculum but also to the pedagogy around delivery.

We appreciate that we are immersed in this daily and the changes to teaching practice are very familiar to us. To support parents understanding and hopefully answer any questions or concerns around pedagogy we will be putting together some curriculum sections in our newsletter over the forth coming weeks. Our first curriculum input will look at the teaching of reading.

This week we have also seen a number of trips taking place in school. I am always extremely grateful to our staff team who organise such fantastic visits to ensure learning takes place both in and outside the classroom.

As I write this newsletter our Year 5 class are currently visiting Chester Cathedral for the annual Pilgrim Day visit. We have been extremely fortunate to secure place on this day as it is well attended by Church schools within the Diocese. The experience will provide the children with a

unique opportunity to visit the cathedral and take part in a variety of exciting activities during the day which will enrich our Religious Education curriculum.

On Tuesday our Year 6 children visited Tarporley High School for their first Challenge Day of the year. The children had a fantastic day enjoying the workshops which were on offer as part of the STEM high school transition package.







Yesterday our Year 4 children visited Blackpool Zoo. The work focused around their class text Gorilla by Anthony Browne and provided the children with the opportunity to see Gorillas as well as other animals in real life. I was delighted to hear that the children received a number of comments about their behaviour and conduct from the general public during their visit. Well done Year 4 - we are very proud of you.









Our brilliant PTA group are rebranding! From now on they will be known as Friends of Bunbury Aldersey. Their focus will continue to be on supporting the school by fundraising for equipment and provision which will benefit all children. After a recent meeting they have set out a calendar of events for the forth coming

term which I know will be extremely beneficial to us all in our busy lives.

This year the Friends of Bunbury Aldersey are raising money to develop our outdoor learning environment with a dedicated learning space linked to science and nature.
