We will be holding our Easter Service this year back in St Boniface Church on Wednesday 30th March at 10.30am. All are parents/carers are welcome to attend. Please can we ensure that all children are wearing correct school uniform for the service and that school hoodies are not worn on this day as part of the uniform.

All money raised will go towards the following projects which have been chosen by the Year 6 committee members: to clear the weeds in the school woods, to plant ferns to absorb C02, to place more litter bins outside so littering becomes less frequent and to buy a compost bin. In total they have raised £132.40

Freddie Year 4 and Natalie year 6 have been raising money for the Unicef Ukraine appeal. They held a cake and coffee sale with their friends from Tattenhall school at the Llantysilio Fell Race last weekend. It was wonderfully supported by a lot of hungry runners (including Mrs Cliffe who won the prize in her age category!) and they raised £300.48 to add to the schools Unicef Ukraine appeal total from 11th March. Well done Freddie and Natalie - what a super achievement.



Belle Year 5 has also been raising money for Cancer Research UK and has started her third year of walking all over cancer! 10000 steps every day in March! I'm incredibly proud of Belle and her support for such a worthy cause.
