



What a fantastic week back we have had to the start of our summer term. This week we welcomed Ada, Archer and Jacob into our Bunbury family. We are delighted to have them in school and look forward to them continuing their learning journey with us.

Our study theme for this term is a STEM based project (science, technology, engineering and maths). Based around the books "Ask a scientist" and

We have started our new study theme with a science week across the school. There has been some exciting and inspiring science and technology work taking place in each classroom and it has been fantastic to hear the enjoyment and enthusiasm around the school corridors. The week has also been enriched by visits from some of our parents who have spoken with the children about how their careers link to the world of science. A huge thank you to Mrs Smith and Mrs Lomax who came into school to talk to the children and support our science week. The week ended this afternoon with a science fair led by pupils from each class in the school hall. A huge thank you to Mrs Gabriel, our science lead, for organising such a fantastic start to our STEM study theme.













Next week we are excited to be starting our onsite swimming lessons in our temporary heated pool. Hopefully you will have all received your letters outlining the arrangements for our KS2 swimming lessons as well as our after school KS1 clubs. By hiring the pool we have been able to provide all our KS2 children with the opportunity to have a series of intensive lessons. This will be something we will be repeating annually meaning that KS2 children with swim each year they are in KS2 rather than just once in Year 4 as we have done previously. I am sure you will agree that this is a fantastic opportunity for our children and enhances our sports provision within school.

Over the Easter holidays we have also been busy improving the provision for our children in school. We have developed a dedicated space to support our pupils and staff with their mental health and well being. "The Nest" is there for all children with resources and materials to support all those who may need it. We have also developed a second library space in-between year 3 and Year 5 for pupils.





Over the forth coming weeks and months there are plans for both further development inside and outside to ensure Bunbury school provision will be the very best it can for all our children. I look forward to being able to share these with you as they are completed.
