<u>Register</u>

On registration parents/carers will be given the access code to the gate used by Bunbury Badgers and shown the signing in/out register which will be located by the entrance to the Club Classroom. Parents must sign in/out and verify the time of arrival/departure. Failure to do so compromises our Safeguarding Policy. If you have any concerns with regards to your child settling into Bunbury Badgers please discuss this with our manager, Gillian Corbett-Mills who will be pleased to work with you.

<u>Absence</u>

Should your child be unable to attend Bunbury Badgers due to illness please ensure that we are notified by email at <u>clubs@bunburyaldersey.cheshire.sch.uk</u> or telephone 01829 260524.

Fees still remain payable for any sessions missed through illness or absence.

Cancellations

One half terms notice is required to cancel your registration. If we do not receive sufficient notice you will be subject to a payment of one-half terms fees as the place will have been reserved for your child.



<u>Collections</u>

If your child is to be collected by someone other than yourself we ask that you contact us before hand in writing, via email or by telephone informing us of the alternative arrangements.

We will not allow any child to leave Club unless prior permission has been given!.

<u>Club Fees</u>

Club fees can be paid online via 'SchoolMoney', childcare vouchers or cheque (payable to RCSAT) Non-payment of fees could result in the loss of your child's place at Bunbury Badgers. Fees will be reviewed annually.

<u>Illness</u>

A full exclusion policy will be displayed on the parent's information board. Children should not attend if they are suffering from vomiting, diarrhoea, raised temperature or any form of contagious disease. Should a child develop any of the above symptoms whilst attending Bunbury Badgers every effort will be made to contact the parent/carer. Full fees are payable for sessions missed through sickness, holidays and cancellations.

<u>Clothing</u>

Please ensure that all clothing is suitably labelled and in addition ensure waterproof clothing is provided for outdoor play during Winter months and sun cream /sun hat over Summer.

<u>Valuables</u>

Please ensure that your child does not bring valuable items into Bunbury Badgers. We are not responsible for lost or damaged items brought in by the children.

Should they need to bring in money for the cake stall or school shop please pop this in a sealed envelope with your child's name on and hand it to a Club staff member for safekeeping.

<u>Behaviour</u>

All children who attend Bunbury Badgers are made aware of the school's behaviour policy regarding acceptable/unacceptable behaviour and encouraged to follow the school's 'Golden Rules' at all times.

The children take part in group discussions to draw up 'Club Rules & Table Manners' charts.
