Car Parking and Speeding

Where children need to be travelling by car please can I ask that you park considerately around the surrounding area **even when the weather is wet** for example by:

- not blocking residents driveways
- not parking on the pavement
- not parking on corners of roads
- not parking in areas where it makes it difficult for children to cross or forces them to walk on the road.
- not parking opposite the school entrance or zig zag lines
- not parking in the minibus zone unless displaying a disability badge

Cones have now been placed opposite the school to ensure that this area is kept free of cars.
