Dear Parents and carers

Another week has ended and despite the closeness to the end of the autumn term it has been another packed week in school.

On Tuesday the transformation of our dedicated Outdoor Quiet Space finally began. Just like our different styles of teaching and learning at Bunbury we realise that children also need to play and socialise in different ways as well. For some children playtime can be quite challenging for many reasons. They may be a quieter character, find

the playground overwhelming or indeed need time to learn the conventions of social interaction. This

space, which will be supervised by a member of staff, will provide opportunities to play and socialise in a quieter area. We know this will make a huge difference to all the children during break and lunchtime and thank the PTA for their support with fundraising to equip this area. I look forward to being able to unveil the finished provision in the near future.





On Wednesday we took our whole school to the New Vic Theatre in Stoke to watch a performance of Alice in Wonderland. Unfortunately, we were delayed only by the parking for the village chip shop - apologies.



Today has been our first Festive Friday of the 2022 Christmas countdown. We began the day with our annual Reindeer Run complete with a special guest visitor. It was wonderful to see all the children looking so festive,

challenging themselves to do as many laps as they could and enjoying listing their Christmas wishes with our very own Father Christmas. A huge thank you as always to all the staff and helpers who enabled us to


Reindeer Run - 2nd December 2022 Online Sponsor Form


