Parents and Carers,

The week of School Fest is fast approaching, children will be participating in outdoor activities every day, school uniform is not required. In the event of hot, sunny weather, please send your child to school wearing a sun hat and high SPF sunscreen. Children will not need reading books or any bags during the week unless they are camping. Please ensure your child has a refillable water bottle and a snack every day.

These are the activities that will be taking place throughout the week:

Petty Pool Outdoor Centre will be attending school for the whole week, they will be providing a range of workshops including:

- A scavenger hunt and mud monsters
- Orienteering and bow saw medallions.
- Fire lighting skills in small groups across the school.
- Team games
- Archery - Children in Key stage 2 will need to wear a long-sleeved top for the Archery workshop on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July.

Additionally, on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July we will have access to:

- Cave Bus, mobile simulated caves
