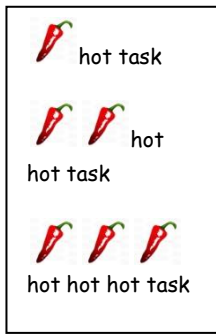


Takeaway Homework



Choose your homework from the menu below. The chilli rating suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. This half term you must attempt at least two tasks. Bring your work back to school on **Wednesday 24th May**, to share with the class and school. **Thank you.**

This terms homework is based on our whole school topic 'Sea of Dreams'. Some of the ideas have come from the children themselves! I am expecting great things (as always!!!).

1. Write an encyclopaedia entry about a mythical sea creature. Can you include a 'what and a wow' introduction? Think creatively about how to display this - could it be a video or a booklet?
2. Go the beach and sketch what you can see. It could be the view from the sand looking out to sea or the view of the town from the beach. If you would like some sketching paper and sketching pencils come and ask Miss Cork!
3. Go to the beach, a field or even your garden and measure out the lengths of different sea creatures. Can you write the length in metres and centimetres? Take some photographs and bring them in!
4. Go to the beach and build a sandcastle! How big can you make it? Can you add shells and seaweed for decoration? Take some photographs and bring them in!
5. Create a fact file or a poster about any Sea Creature. Think about paragraphs and subheadings. You could make one big poster, pic collage or a little book!
6. Create a 3D model of a sea creature (it would be great to have some Blue Whales to add to our writing display!). This could be a wire model, paper mache, mod rock, lego, sock puppet etc. You could display it in a water tank - make an underwater scene/den for your sea creature.
8. Make a 3D boat like the one in the Story! This could be made from paper mache, lego, wire or even a butter tub! Can you make it float? You could add a moving propeller - have a look on Miss Cork's favourite website 'Pinterest' for some ideas! Again could be displayed in a water tank to show it floats!
9. Make something edible linked to the Sea of Dreams topic. It could be a 'jelly' jelly fish, marshmallow sand castle, a giant ice cream cone cake, cakes that look like fish and chips etc!! Get creative - you all know Miss Cork loves cake!
