Schools Fest 2025

As we are now in the final term of the school year we are rapidly approaching our Schools Fest week. For those new to Bunbury school Schools Fest is an enrichment week for all our children in school from nursery to Year 6. This year will be a special celebration as it will be our fifth

anniversary. As in previous years, this will involve a whole week of exciting outdoor challenges, incorporating physical games and expressive arts activities, to be held on school premises with some additional off-site challenges. School Fest will be held the week beginning **7th July 2025**. Children in Nursery will take part in at least two activities each day. Reception and Key Stage 1 will undertake several daytime activities over the week, and years 3-6 will enjoy multiple daytime challenges which will also include an overnight camp for Year 6, on Monday 7th July. Activities will have a strong emphasis on building skills, problem solving and encouraging



collaboration but ultimately, will be an opportunity to create memorable learning experiences and to have

fun with their friends. This year we have the addition of Family Fest on the Friday afternoon, where family members are invited to join in with the activities, fun and entertainment.

School Fest is of huge benefit to our children's mental health, group activities will develop the children's self-belief, resilience, co-operation, problem solving skills and will improve well-being. As a staff we are aware that education is more than the acquisition of knowledge and by improving young people's skills, values, relationships, and personal development, we can significantly enhance learning and achievement.

Co-ordinating and organising the activities for School Fest have already begun, by popular demand the 7.5m climbing wall, caving experience, silent disco, Big Bubble Man and AmaSing Drumming and dance class are booked to return and you'll all be pleased to hear that Mr Friel will be holding his Nerf War sessions. Additionally, we have secured a mobile farm, a mosaic workshop and more! Key Stage 2 children will be participating in water skills which was a huge success last year. We are also planning to have 5th anniversary t-shirts for School Fest 2025 for staff and children, which brings a sense of togetherness for the whole school during our School Fest celebrations.
