Yesterday, I saw a grey cat creeping across the park.

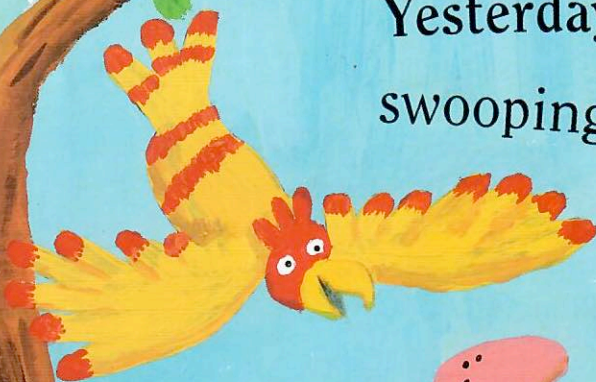
Yesterday, I saw a brown dog sitting by the pond.

Yesterday, I saw someone running to catch a bus.

Then, to make your poem funny, make the final thing in your list something that it would be impossible for you to see:

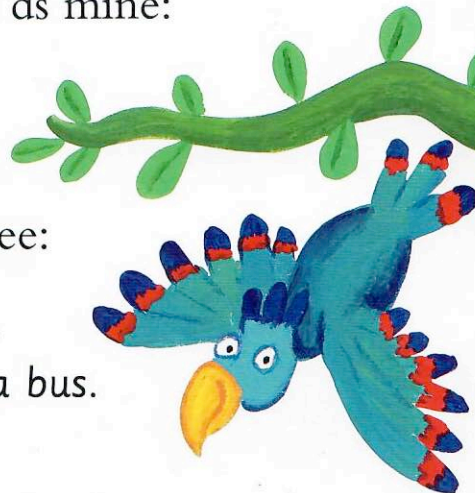
Yesterday, I saw a tree whispering to the grass.
