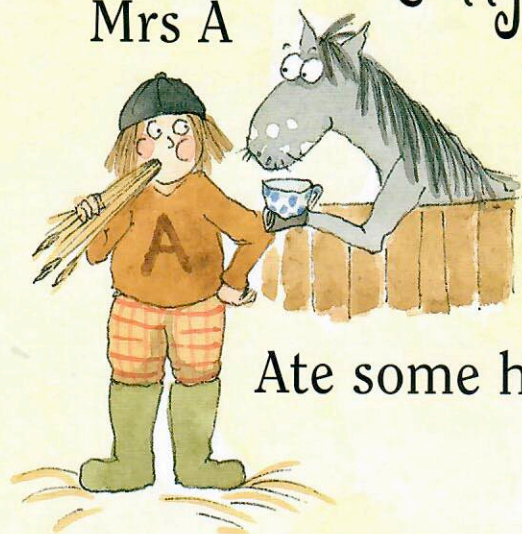


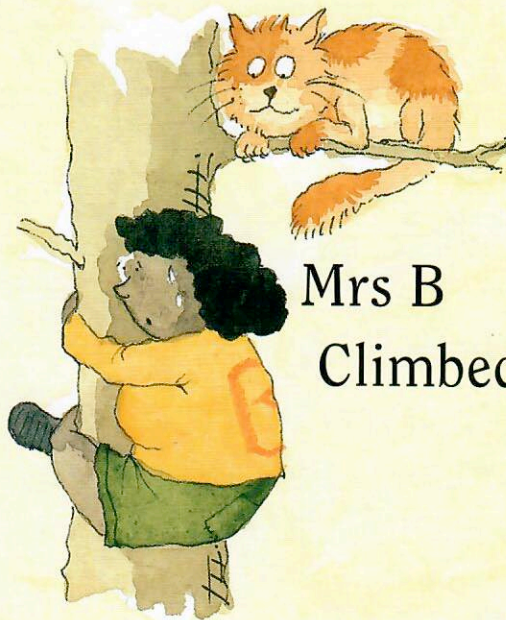

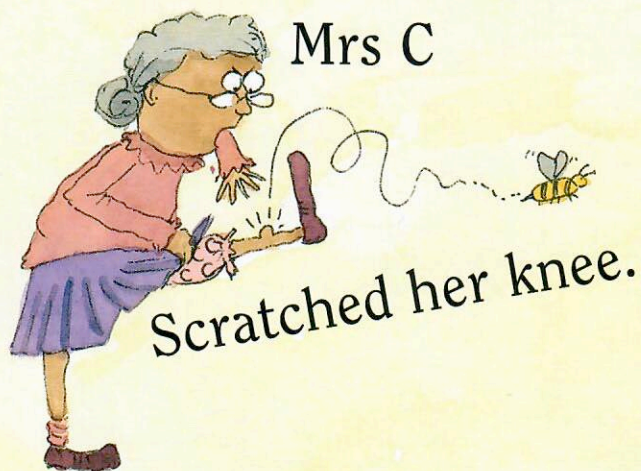
Ate some hay.

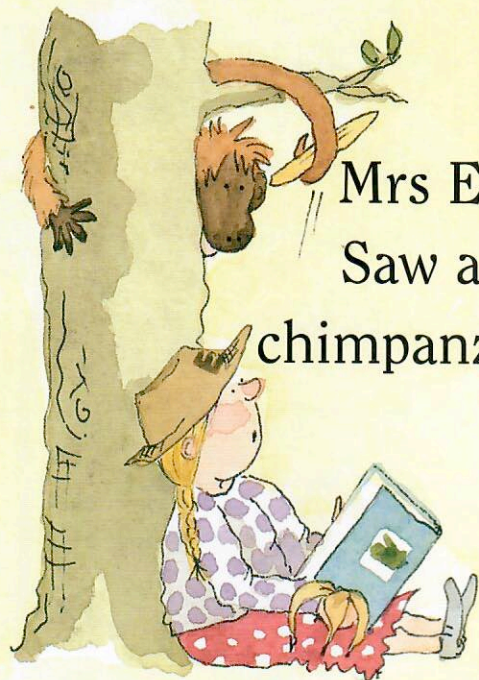
Scratched her knee.

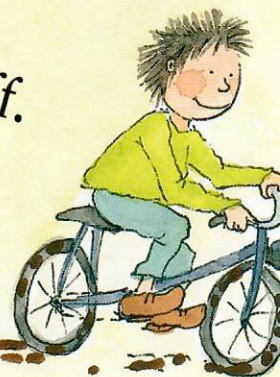

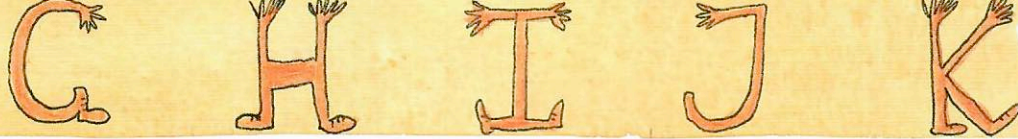

About this poem

“ Here is a rhyming poem that is based on the alphabet. I got the idea when I was wondering how the letters of the alphabet might behave, if each letter was a person. ”

Over to you

Choose some letters and use them to write your own alphabet poem.

First, make a list of the letters of the alphabet and try to find some rhymes for each letter, e.g.

I – fly, pie

V – recipe, me

J – tray, day

W – trouble you!

You don't have to include every letter – some are tricky to find a rhyme for (the hardest ones are H, W and X!).

Pick a letter and write your first line:

Mrs I

To write the second line, choose a rhyme and make up a short line:

Mrs I

Ate a fly.

Do this for as many letters as you choose, until your poem is complete.

More ideas

You could write a poem using numbers instead of letters:

Mr One

Had lots of fun.

Mr Two

Saw a kangaroo.

Mr Three

Hurt his knee....
